Program Intake

In 2026, the WestVic Golf Development Program will be based on handicap instead of age to work with those at a higher handicap level to aid their development in lowering their handicap throughout 2026. To ensure we cater for this change in the best way for athletes, we will be prioritising applications for those with a handicap of **24 and below**. If your handicap is above 24, we still encourage you to apply.

Application Process

To apply for the WestVic Golf program you must complete the form located on our website or at the bottom of this document. Within this form there will be questions relating to results, goals and your coachability as an athlete. WestVic also selects athletes based on other contributing factors such as the athlete's alignment with our guiding values.

Lumin Sports App

FedUni WestVic uses Lumin Sports App as our Athlete Management System. All Golf athletes will be assigned to the app allowing WestVic staff to help the athlete manage their Strength & Conditioning programs, wellness and all program operations and communication.

Cost
